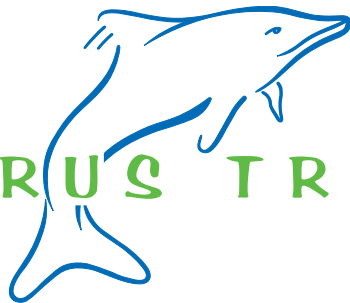

Notes for Applicants

PELORUS TRUST

The Pelorus Trust is a charitable trust that has as its primary objective the promotion and development of amateur sport in New Zealand. As a secondary objective the Trust also supports various charitable or not-for-profit community purposes.

The Trust is licensed to operate gaming machines under strict rules imposed by the Gambling Act (2003), associated Game Rules and Regulations. In addition the Trust has its own funding objectives, grants criteria and rules.

To ensure the maximum community benefit of the funds raised the Trustees initiate several funding projects as well as encouraging a broad cross section of sporting and community groups to apply for a grant.

The Trust maintains a comprehensive website at www.pelorustrust.net.nz. We strongly recommend that all potential applicant groups visit this site and read its contents. The Pelorus Trust meets regularly to consider applications. Closing dates are usually posted on the website. Please ensure that applications are received by the Trust at least two working days before the closing date. Applicants are notified by email of the outcome of their application a few days after the meeting.

The following notes correspond with the numbering shown on the application form. They may assist you to complete the application form.

SECTION A – CONTACT DETAILS

The **applicant organisation** must be an identifiable formal group, association, trust, society or not-for-profit organisation. We cannot accept applications from individuals or families.

All correspondence, including a grant remittance email, if approved, will be sent to the nominated **email address** of the applicant organisation. Please ensure this email address is secure and can be accessed by the applicant organisation.

The Trust may phone the nominated **contact person** to seek clarification or additional information regarding your application. Please ensure this person knows about this application.

SECTION B – ORGANISATION DETAILS

This section helps us confirm your non-profit, non-commercial status. The Trust cannot fund any organisation where the people in that organisation will accrue a personal or commercial benefit.

If the applicant is **GST** registered, only the GST exclusive amount will be funded. If approved, any grant made by the Pelorus Trust shall be treated as an unconditional gift. No portion is claimed by the Pelorus Trust as a deduction for Goods and Services Tax paid.

Please staple your organisation's bank account verification to this application. You may not use a business or personal account deposit slip. This information is mandatory as it forms part of the audit trail should funds be granted to your organisation.

SECTION C – FUNDING DETAILS

The Trust must not grant funds where the possibility exists that the applicant group may also receive funding from another source for the same goods or services to an amount which **exceed the value of those goods or services**. This is called **double-dipping**. If your organisation seeks to apply to multiple funding agencies we strongly recommend you apply for different items/projects to each funding body.

The Trust maintains a policy where **funds are generally returned to the area from which they were raised**. Nominating our nearest member venue will assist us to define your general geographic area.

The Trust is keen to determine what other fundraising efforts the applicant organisation has undertaken to contribute to the overall funding amount required. In some instances, as a result of a desire to see a wide spread of available funds, the Trust is only able to partly fund applications. If part funding is not appropriate in your case (i.e. you would prefer all or nothing), please write the word ALL in the minimum amount question box.

SECTION D – GRANT DETAILS

You may apply for any purpose that is defined as an "authorised purpose" by the Gambling Act. This means a charitable or non-commercial purpose that is beneficial to the community. The Trust has further defined this to mean:

"The Pelorus Trust may distribute funds through charitable, sporting or other community based organisations. Funds may be distributed to, but not limited to, any cultural, philanthropic, charitable, sporting, educational or any other purpose that benefits the community or section of it.

Grants shall benefit only amateur sport where the aim shall be to assist participants to play their sport, improve their skills and generally participate in a healthy recreational activity. Grants may benefit the sport of racing through the provision of facilities and grounds maintenance. No grants shall benefit professional sportspeople to play their sport or racing owners, trainers or jockeys.

Grants to charitable and not-for-profit community groups shall generally be for the purposes of health, welfare and the relief of poverty, for the benefits of the arts, culture or kapa haka, or for community assistance groups such as rescue helicopters.

Grants to schools or other educational institutes shall be for the provision of equipment or services that foster continuous learning and youth development."

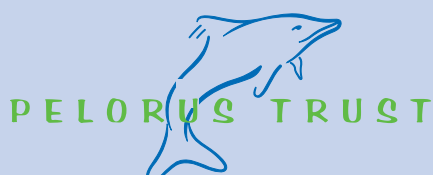
There are some things the Trust will not usually fund. Please check our website for details as this information is constantly updated.

The Trust will not grant funds retrospectively. This means your organization needs to plan carefully to ensure that if **funds are required** for an event, the Trust has plenty of time to consider the application (and make any grant) before the event takes place. Similarly, the Trust cannot grant funds for previously incurred debts.

The Trust needs to ensure that the applicant has obtained **competitive quotes** for the goods or services it needs. It is preferred that the quote provider dates the quote and it is on company letterhead. The quote must be current (i.e. dated less than three months prior to the date of application). If the applicant cannot provide two quotes we need to know why. If the applicant has a preferred supplier arrangement with one provider please clearly indicate this but also provide another quote as a comparison.

SECTION E – DECLARATION

This section must be completed by two principal officers of the applicant organisation. Original signatures **MUST** be signed on the declaration **NO** copies will be accepted. All applications must be posted or couriered to Pelorus Trust including the original signatures (section E) no email or faxed applications will be accepted. Please read this section carefully. It is highly likely that your organisation, if successful, will be asked to account for the use of funds granted by either the Trust's auditors or Inspectors from the Department of Internal Affairs or both. It is also important to note that the completion of an application form does not constitute approval of the request or, if approved, that further payments to the same applicant for the same purpose will be approved in future. The Trustees maintain an unfettered discretion to decline or refuse any application even if the submitted application meets all relevant criteria and funds are available.

SECTION E | Declaration

The organisation and associated individuals authorise the Pelorus Trust to store any of the information included in, or obtained in connection with, this application and to disclose that information together with the Pelorus Trust's decisions on the application for any purpose including without limitation; national publication of grants, storage on a national database and compliance with Department of Internal Affairs licence conditions.

In the event of any audit irregularity or sponsorship/financial arrangement with a member venue being discovered (e.g. misapplication of funds), we agree to refund immediately the grant in whole or in part as required by the Pelorus Trust at its absolute discretion.

Any unspent funds will be returned to the Pelorus Trust unless otherwise directed.

Grant monies will only be used for the purpose for which quotes were supplied and the grant approved.
